

If One Votes YES, Data Shows

- Youth use marijuana higher in states where legal.¹
- Less than 5% of registered medical marijuana users in legalized states have life threatening conditions.²
- All non-FDA approved medical marijuana remains federally ILLEGAL, subject to arrest and penalty.³

If One Votes YES, Data Shows

- Medical marijuana doctor recommendations are filled at medical marijuana dispensary via 'bud tenders', not by pharmacists. Potency and dosage may vary.
- Cost is NOT covered by insurance or Medicaid.

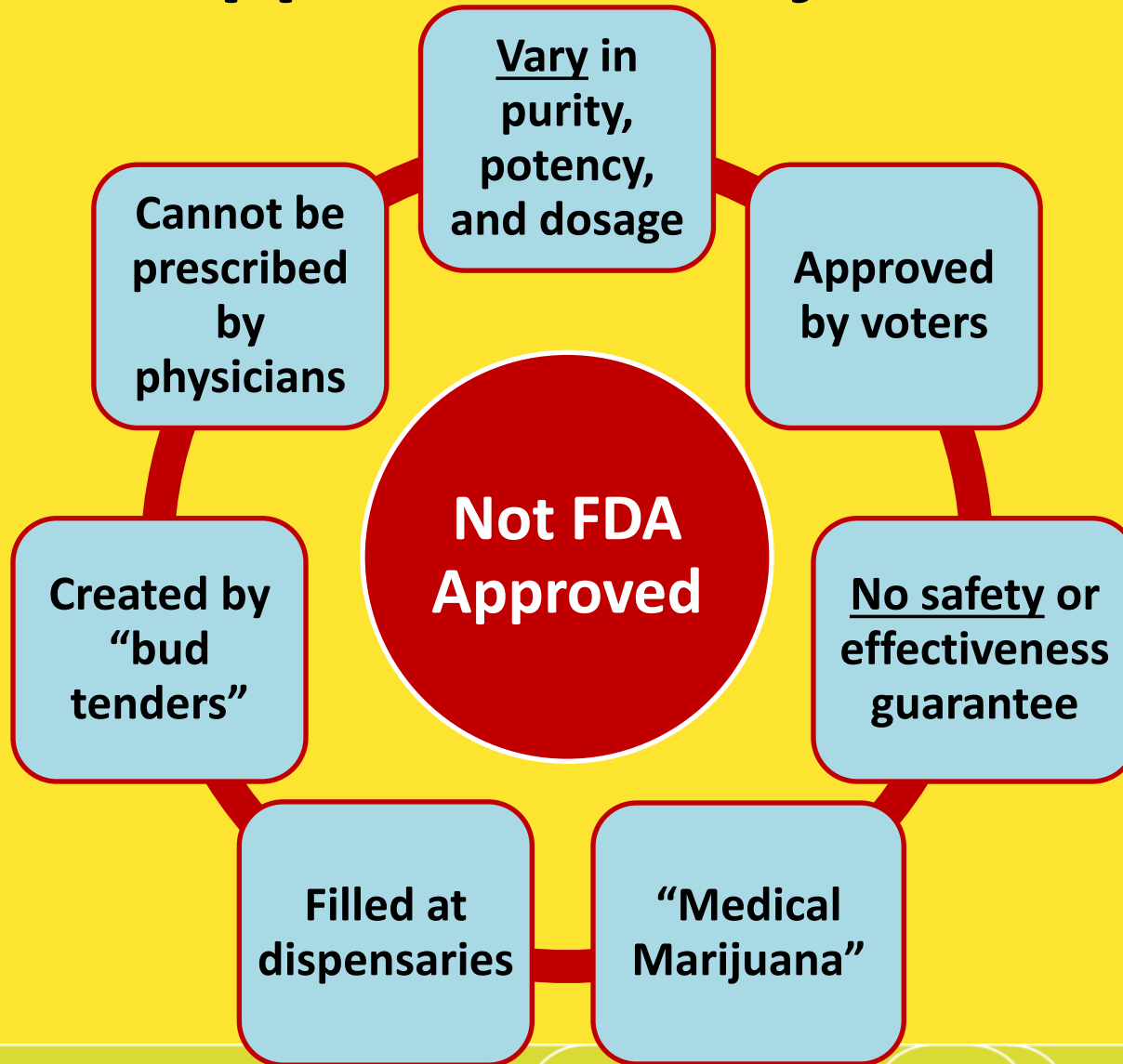

If One Votes YES, Data Shows

- Denver, CO: Drug & narcotics crimes up 12.5% in 2015 with homicide rates up 74%.¹
- Colorado: Usage by youth (age 12 to 17) increased from 8.29% to 11.16% after voter-approved medical marijuana. School suspensions increased 32%.²
- Platte County: Past 30-day teen usage is 7.1%.³

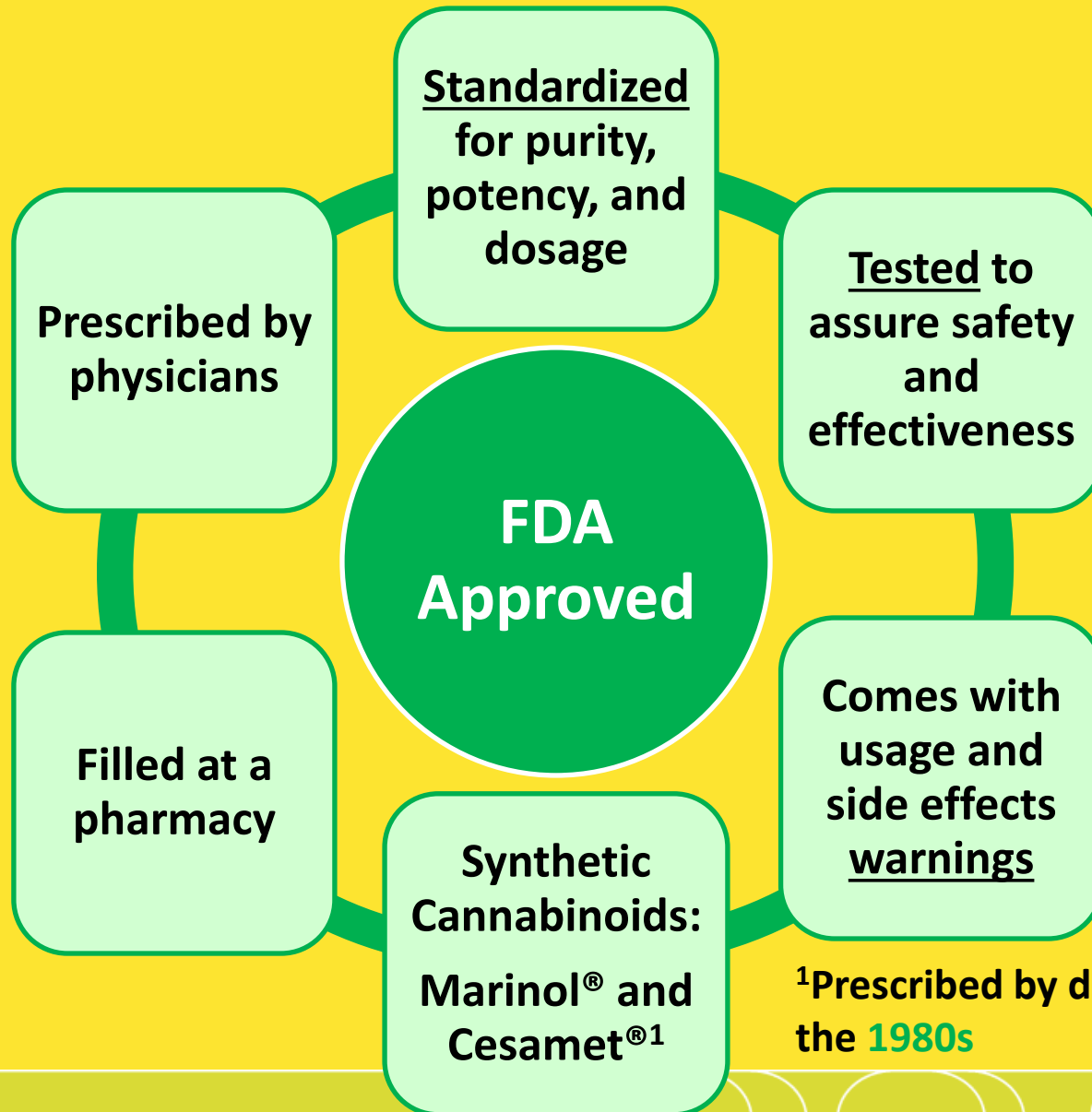
